Its going to be the summer of 2021 soon and that means the summer 2020 Olympics will finally be happening!! Have your kids join us this summer as we go for the gold in saving!

The program will run from **June 1st to August 7th**. The last day to sign up your child for the summer savings program is June 5th. Each youth is to deposit a minimum of \$.50 once a week for the 10 weeks of the program. At the end of the program, any youth that deposited once a week will be eligible to join the credit union at Urban Air in Lincoln to work on their Olympic skills. Any youth that completes the 10 weeks will also have their money (up to \$500) put into a special high yield account where their money can earn them up to 5% interest for 5 months. The interest rates are tiered according to how much money is in the high yield. The table to the left gives a break down of those tiers. Be sure to mark your calendars, you don't want to miss this!
